

OPT-OUT FORM
Military Recruitment
(Minor Students, under 18 years of age)

Two federal laws, Section 9528 of the ESEA as amended by the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001*, and the Education Bill, as amended by the National Defense Authorization Act of Fiscal year 2002, require local educational agencies, (LEA) receiving assistance under the Elementary and Secondary Act of 1965 (ESEA) to provide military recruiters, upon request, with three directory information categories – names, addresses and telephone listings – unless parents have advised the LEA that they do not want their minor child’s information shared without their specific written consent. These Acts require that military recruiters be allowed access to all high school students and their directory information as is customarily afforded all other representatives of postsecondary agencies or prospective employers.

The purpose of this form is to provide you as parent an opportunity to make a conscious decision regarding the involvement of your child with military recruiters. Consider the statements below and place an X in the space provided for each option, sign and return the document to your child’s school.

- I do not wish to have my child’s directory information disclosed to military recruiters.

- I do not wish to have my child participate in any military recruitment activities including face-to-face contact.

- I do not wish my child to participate in the administration of the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB).
